

### Cold Storage Warehouses, Refrigerated Trailers, Ocean Containers

- It's essential for Blankets to be in the main air flow for maximum absorption of ethylene.
- For coolers and warehouses select Blanket size to match diameter of fan blades as closely as possible, use one blanket per fan for best level of protection
- It's normal for Blankets to get dirty on the outside, over time. As the absorbing beads filter ethylene, the filter material also traps dirt particles from the air.
- Air Repair<sup>™</sup> beads are a bright purple color when fresh. Upon exposure to air and as ethylene is oxidized, they turn brown starting from the surface and eventually penetrating to the core of the bead.
- Blankets should be replaced when 80% of the filter beads have turned from purple to brown. This is determined by routine visual inspection. Remove a bead and crush it, if the inside is purple, then it's still actively absorbing ethylene.

#### Cold Storage Warehouse Installation

- Remove Blanket from the barrier bag packaging
- 2. Remove self-locking tie taped to the outside of the bag
- 3. Hang the Blanket on the return side of the fan, suspended in direct air flow, leave about 8 to 12-inches clearance between the Blanket and fan. Secure with self-locking ties or metal hooks (not included).
- 4. Use one Blanket for each fan in the storage area








### **Refrigerated Trailer Installation**

- Remove Blanket from the barrier bag packaging
- 2. Remove self-locking tie taped to the outside of the bag
- 3. Attach the Blanket to the bottom of the refrigeration unit, secure with self-locking tie. Fold upward and secure with tape to the front of the unit, leaving several inches clearance on the bottom for air flow.







SIDE VIEW FRONT VIEW

#### Ocean Container Installation

- 1. Two or three 20in x 25in Blankets can be used in one container
- Remove Blanket from the barrier bag packaging
- Remove self-locking tie taped to the outside of the bag
- 4. Hang Blankets from the ceiling of the container near the rear doors, secure with self-locking ties or metal hooks (not included).
